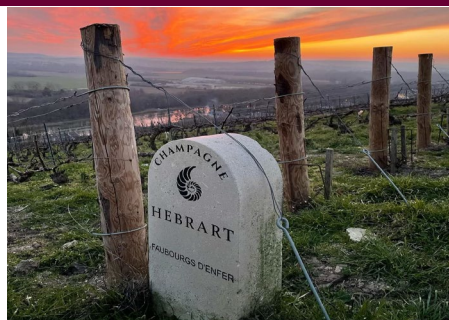

Champagne Marc Hebrart > small introduction

The softly spoken and unassuming Marc Hébrart purchased his first vines at the age of 17 and took over the reins at his father's small Mareuil-sur-Aÿ domaine in 1998. Members of the Special Club since 1985, the Hébrart family have long been serious growers, but Marc has taken the estate to new heights. He works the soils and employs synthetic products only at flowering to protect the crop. "I need to have a good crop so I have enough grapes to make choices in the cellar," he explains. He uses only organic fertilizers and debuds to limit yields. And he's trying to build up his stocks so he can offer older vintages for sale, thinking that their reserves constitute one of the important advantages of the grandes marques. The Hébrart style is supremely—even deceptively—charming, emphasizing pretty fruit tones and structured around succulent acids. Yet the wines reward contemplation, too, and age very well indeed. All the releases here come warmly recommended.

Peter Liem writes of Hébrart on Champnguide.net: "Hébrart's wines have a broad appeal: if you like to think about your wines, they're intellectually engaging enough to satisfy you; on the other hand, if you're just looking to drink, they're simply delicious. The wines are full and generous without being weighty, complex and soil-driven without being demanding. Overall, the entire range is of consistently high quality, and represents excellent value for the money."

THE HISTORY OF CHATEAU CLARISSE -

Driven by the passion for wine and the taste for challenge, Olivia and Didier Le Calvez have been signing their own wine since 2010 in one of the most illustrious regions of the Bordeaux constellation, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Saint-Emilionnais.

After several years of research started in 2007, the dream of Olivia and Didier took the form of an authentic Gironde stone nestled in the green landscape and all in gentle curves of the right bank. This old winery with magnificent wine cellars, which for more than a century has been in the hands of the Estager family, is surrounded by a beautiful vineyard (perched at 89 meters) on the plateau of Puisseguin, one of the four "satellite" villages of Saint-Emilion. Only a humble brook, the Barbanne, a sub-tributary of the Dordogne, separates them from the illustrious strong city.

"After two years of research, we had a real favorite for a vineyard property combining ideal terroir and climate, combined with a perfect vineyard, 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc. To develop a wine as I imagined it, rich in perfume and subtle".

Thus was born Château CLARISSE, the name of their daughter (who was three years old at the birth of the first bottle, in 2010), to write a beautiful family story...

2000 CHATEAU LEOVILLE LAS CASES

RATED WA 98 POINTS

DRINK : 2025-2060

Tasted blind as a vintage comparison at the Valandraud vertical, the 2000 Leoville-Las-Cases is a quite fabulous, magisterial Saint Julien that is only just beginning to flex its muscles. It has a very intense and beautifully defined bouquet with mineral rich blackberry and bilberry scents, outstanding focus and harmony, and very well-integrated oak. The palate is medium-bodied with fine tannin, impressive backbone and focus in situ. There is a touch of mint infusing the fruit here, superb tension with a touch of mulberry and Hoi Sin lingering on the finish that still feels backward and sinewy. What was remarkable was to observe the melioration in the glass, achieving wondrous energy and delineation with time, still improving after a couple of hours. Buy it, cellar it, drink it. Tasted December 2016.

2005 CHATEAU PALMER

RATED WA 97 POINTS

DRINK : 2022-2050

Tasted at the Château Palmer vertical in London, the 2005 Château Palmer is a legend in the making. Apparently the vines received 57% less rain than average, yet the 2005 shrugs off any water deficiency and has nurtured a wondrously pixelated bouquet, whereby mineralité shines through the black cherry and blueberry fruit. Search deeper and you discover veins of graphite that impart a Pauillac-like allure. The palate is medium-bodied and intense, but it is not overwhelming, a Margaux that is galvanized with a firm backbone thereby ensuring this will age over the long term. The symmetry here is enthralling - a 2005 that is destined for greatness. The only question is whether it will surpass the 2009 or 2010 Palmer? It will be fun finding out. Tasted May 2015.

2010 CHATEAU FIGEAC

RATED WA 97

DRINK : 2020-2047

Deep garnet coloured, the 2010 Figeac bursts from the glass with gregarious scents of baked blueberries, black cherry compote and chocolate box with hints of camphor, pencil lead and iron ore. Medium to full-bodied, the palate has beautifully ripe, velvety tannins and bold freshness supporting the generous fruit, finishing long and layered.

As far as we are concerned, nothing has changed. They continue to work with the highest quality raw materials and Eric Germain continues to make the wines, as he has done for over fifteen years. Indeed, now that Eric is entirely free from other constraints, we have noticed the wines' gain in precision over the last few vintages! There is no bâtonnage and extended maturation in barrel, giving the white wines greater tension, elegance, energy and purity. In Christophe Marrin, they now, also, have a specialist red winemaker who will work under Eric. We are already seeing finer, more elegant red wines as a result.

The Bourgogne Blanc "Terroir Noble" comes from vines all situated in the communes of Puligny, Chassagne and Meursault. The Bourgogne Rouge "Terroir Noble" is exclusively from old vines around Volnay and Pommard. Both are excellent.

This is a small to medium sized negociant business of the highest quality.

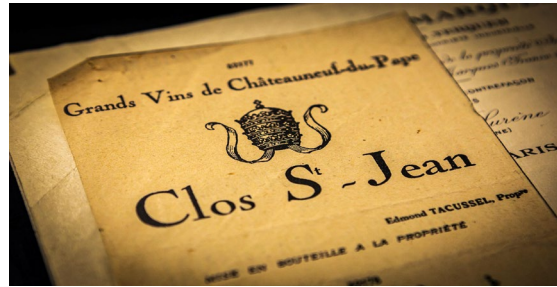

CLOS ST JEAN - OFFICIAL IMPORTER



Edmond Tacussel founded Clos Saint Jean in 1900. The estate takes its name from the lieux-dits Cabane de de Saint Jean and Coteaux de Saint Jean. It is now managed by his great grandsons Vincent and Pascal Maurel.

The brothers have made extensive changes to their winemaking and commercial operations since 2002, and are now among the appellation's most successful producers. The estate also brought Philippe Cambie on board as consultant oenologist.

It is one of the largest winegrowers in the appellation, with over 43 ha of vines. Many of the vineyards are in the southwestern part of the appellation, around Bedarides.

The domaine first produced two special cuvees, La Combe des Fous and Deus Ex Machina in 2003, and a third wine, Sanctus Sanctorum, in 2007. Clos Saint Jean has a single hectare of white wine varieties (1/3 Grenache Blanc, 1/3 Clairette, and 1/3 Roussanne). After pressing the grapes are half fermented in tank and half in new and previously-used barrels.

DOMAINE DU PEGAU - OFFICIAL IMPORTER



Owned by father and daughter team Paul and Laurence Féraud, Domaine du Pegau is one of the great estates in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. The benchmark producer of traditionally styled Châteauneuf, Pegau is justifiably ranked among the greatest wines in the world.

The Férauds have been growing vines in Châteauneuf-du-Pape since 1670, with titles to their earliest vineyards dating back to 1733. They also grew cherries and olives.

The only child of Paul and Odette, Laurence grew up in Avignon city with her Italian grandmother. She studied first degree Viticulture and Oenology. Her father Paul was vine grower since 14 years old. He worked with his brothers and sister at the family house.

Laurence left for Paris to begin wine studies, and after various jobs in wine sales, she returned to help and manage the family estate. Laurence was full of ideas, and to differentiate themselves, proposed creating a family domaine with a unique name and label. She and Paul and Odette (her mother) launched Domaine du Pégau in 1987, naming the estate after the terracotta jugs used in the Pope's summer residence that gave the village its name. At that time, the domaine had only 5 hectares of vines and much of the production was still sold in bulk to the négociant.

In the years that followed, Laurence gradually took on more responsibility, bought top old vineyards when available and built a new winery. She increased sales by expanding exports, and the profits were reinvested. The totality of the 1990 vintage was sold in bottle, and by this time Pégau had gained renown as one of the top domaines in Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Though the estate has scaled great heights and now includes nearly 72 hectares under vine, it is a hallmark that the winegrowing remains deeply traditional and has changed very little in the past 100 years.

As owner and winemaker, Laurence has ensured Pegau remains a benchmark for old-school, traditionally styled Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Ever restless, tireless and ambitious, she has converted her white

Châteauneuf-du-Pape vineyards to biodynamic agriculture, and in 2012 tripled the family's holdings with the purchase of a 40 hectares estate in Sorgues (Côtes du Rhône and Côtes du Rhône Villages) that was renamed "Chateau Pegau". She also manages a successful line of négociant wines under the Sélection Laurence Féraud label.

Laurence's son Maxim and daughter Justine are both passionate about wine and have sharp palates. Since 2021 they run another

The Azienda Agricola Azelia, in the centre of the area of Barolo production, is nowadays composed of 16 hectares and it produces, on average, 80,000 bottles per year. Luigi is supported by his wife Lorella and his son Lorenzo, who bears the name of his grandfather and who represents the fifth generation of wine producers. The family management is essential as it permits an extreme precision in every step of the production.

Great care is given to the work in the vineyards. Wine is made there from old vines which produce very few grapes. The low yields are further reduced through the green harvest, indispensable to select fruits, to have a uniform ripening and an impeccable quality.

The palate strikes a fine balance of concentrated fruit, loads of powdery tannins, and energetic bursts of fresh acidity. It has a deep core of concentrated, perfumed fruit with the first faint touches of umami character and a long finish driven by floral and iron tones. I can't get enough of this wine!

The 2013 La Muse, like all of the 2013s, comes about one-third from Alexander Valley vineyards, 40-plus percent from Chalk Hill, and the rest Knights Valley and Bennett Valley – all high-elevation hillside vineyards. A blend of 89% Merlot, 8% Cabernet Franc and 3% Malbec at 14.3% alcohol, the wine is amazingly like a great vintage of Petrus, with mulberry, black cherry, licorice, truffle and unctuous, thick, juicy fruit all present in this full-bodied masterpiece. The tannins are still present. The wine has purity and savory presence and is remarkable. The finish goes on for well past a minute. This wine would probably benefit from 5-8 years of bottle age and last 40-50 years.
